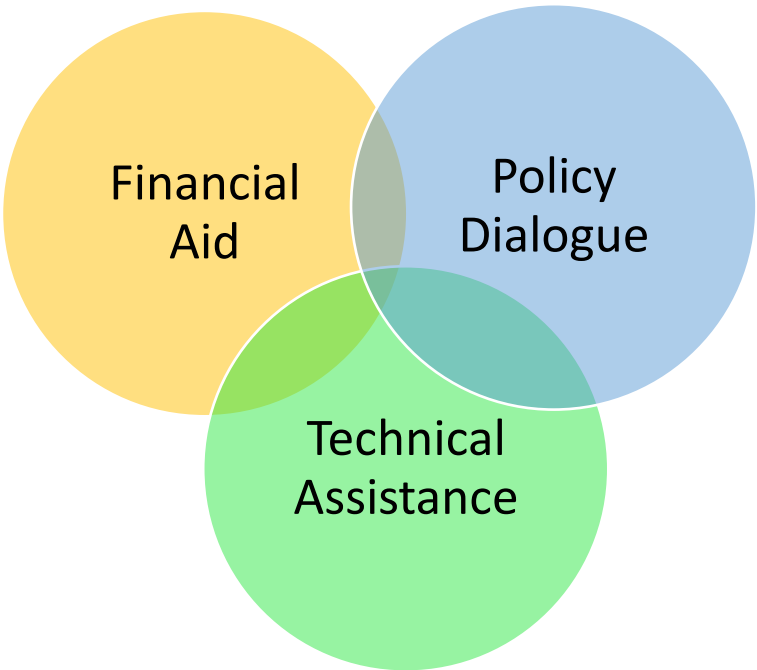
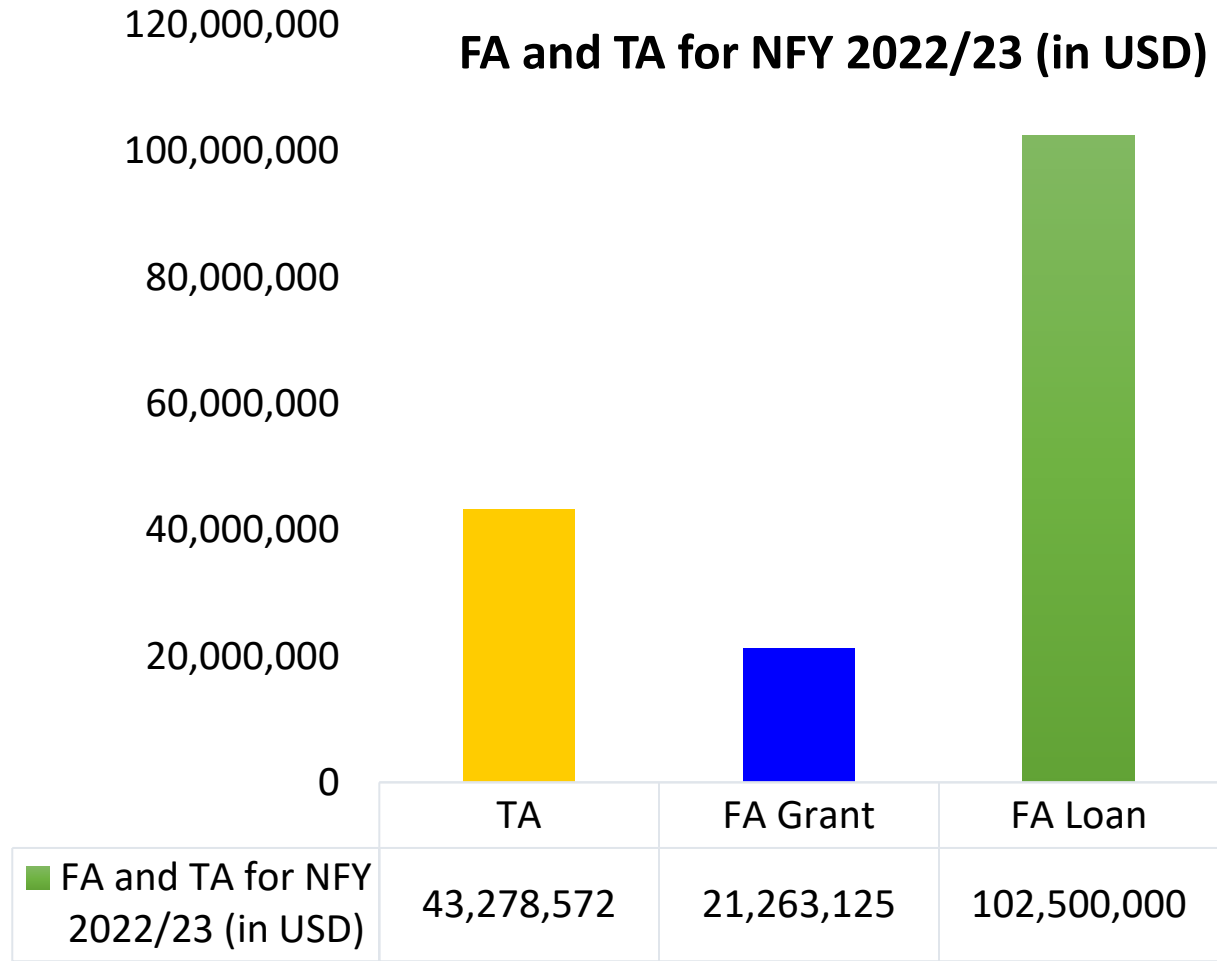
Strategic Priorities: FY 2022/23



PRIORITIES

- Strengthening local health systems (health in federalism);
- NCDs (children & adolescents); Budget Assistance to LGs; HR competency;
- Urban Health; Typhoid & HPV vaccination; BHS dashboard;
- Promoting GESI through targeted programs such as Aama reform, Disability friendly health services; Digitalization of Social Accountability; Adolescents Friendly Health services
- Nepal Health Assembly; Policy Dialogue; One Health; Health in All Policies;
- Second generation Aama reform;
- National health insurance
- Integrated public health emergencies; Multi-hazard and climate-resilient health infrastructure; Genomic sequencing; Global Health Security;
- Improving fiscal space in health, Data for Performance improvement;
- Quality health systems; Provider BCC; Air quality, WASH +
- Strengthening the logistic management system and commodity security

Moving Forward

- Timely endorsement of Nepal Health Sector Strategic Plan, 2022- 2030
- Enhancing quality **Partnership** in health sector
 - Health sector SWAp in federal system (three spheres of the govt) and international development partnership
 - Joint Financing Arrangement (JFA)
 - Joint Consultative Meeting, Partners' Forum, and Joint Reviews (align with the federalised structure)
- Constituting a robust mechanism for timely settlement of ineligibles incurred in the implementation of AWPB
- **Harmonised TA framework across the three levels of government**
- Health in All Policies and Engaging All for Health; broaden **Social Accountability in health sector**
- (We all need meaningful) engagement in planning, monitoring the execution and review of health sector across the three levels of govt (but How)?
- **Increasing Fiscal Space for health and allocating health resources to cater to the changing BoD pattern (NCDs has major share of DALYs)**
- Pandemic preparedness & response to public health emergencies, QoC, healthcare waste management, Social security in health, Multi-hazard & climate-resilient health systems & infrastructure
- **Planned/systematic/smooth transitioning of health systems – federalism, economic graduation by 2026**
- Operationalization of multisectoral engagement to address health determinants and public policies (Examples, Fiscal policies to reduce tobacco, alcohol and sugar sweetened beverages consumption, road safety, healthy municipalities, suicide prevention, etc.)
